IMPORTANT - The first step you need to take is to ensure your safety! Please take time to read and undertsand these instructions before assembling your furniture.


Keep children and animals away from the assembly area. This furniture contains small parts that could cause choking if swallowed.



We hope you enjoy your furniture for many years to come and thank you again for your purchase.



Parts & Fittings













Loosely insert 8 bolts (K) with sprung washer (N) and flat washer (P) into each side of head and footboard (A&B). Note: Do not fully locate the bolts but leave 10mm protruding.

Fit the side panels (C) locating the brackets behind the flat washers. Once all four corners are located, make sure the bed is square but don't tighten any bolts yet.









Fix slat (J) to double plastic cap (H). Fix single plastic caps (G) onto each end then connect onto centre support bar (E) & metal support rails of side panels (C) by gently pushing into the side and centre rails.
