TOP TIP

Identify all of the fittings, make sure that you have them all prepared and familiarise yourself with each component, to make things easier when you are putting it all together.

Keep children and animals away from the assembly area.

This furniture contains small parts that could cause choking if swallowed.

Keep all plastic wrapping materials away from children to avoid danger of suffocation.

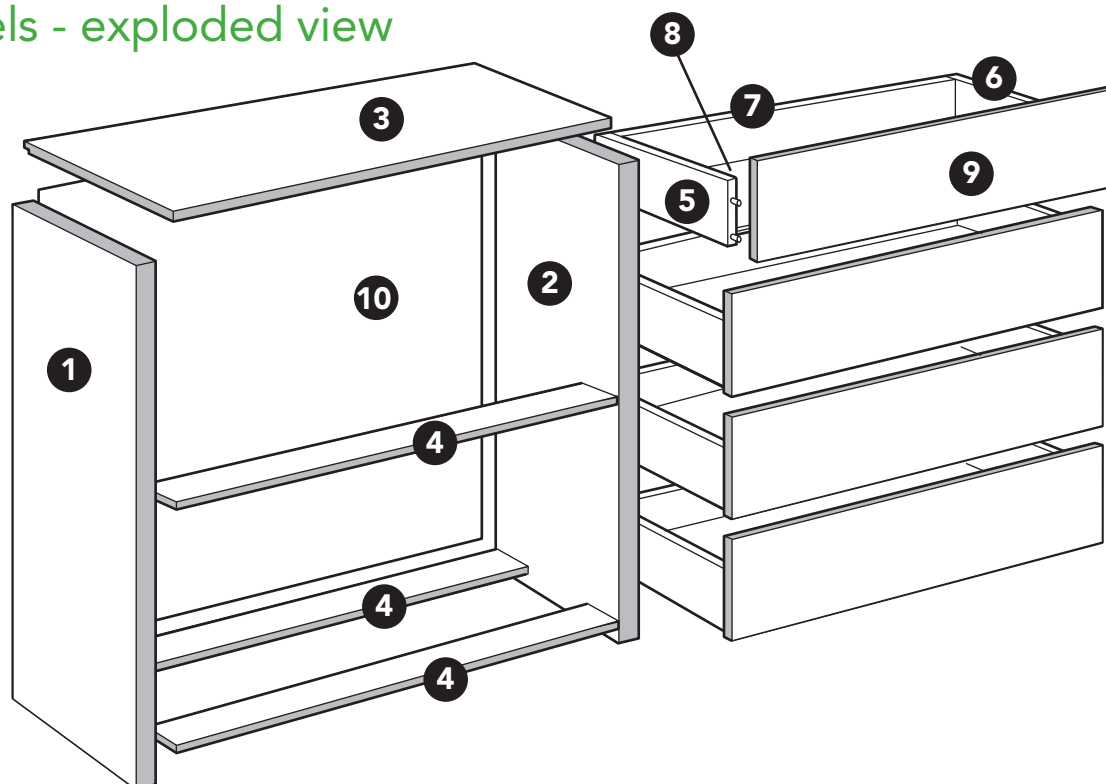
Ensure that all packaging is disposed of carefully and responsibly.

Make sure that you allow enough space to move around when assembling your furniture.

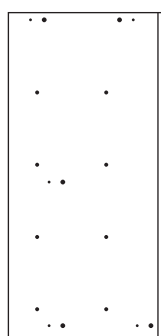

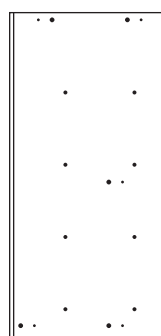
Panels - exploded view

Check the pack and make sure you have all the parts listed above. If not, contact the helpline on 08451 656565 who will be able to help you.

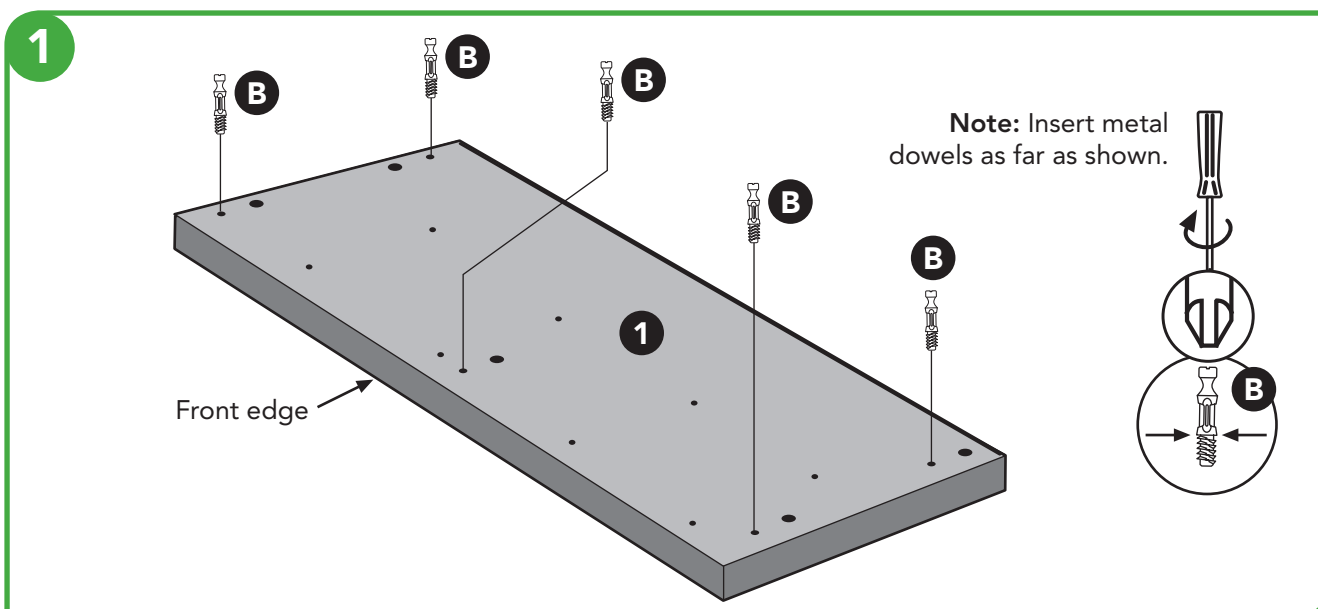
When you are ready and sure that you have the right tools to hand, you will need plenty of space and a clean dry area for assembly.

Important information

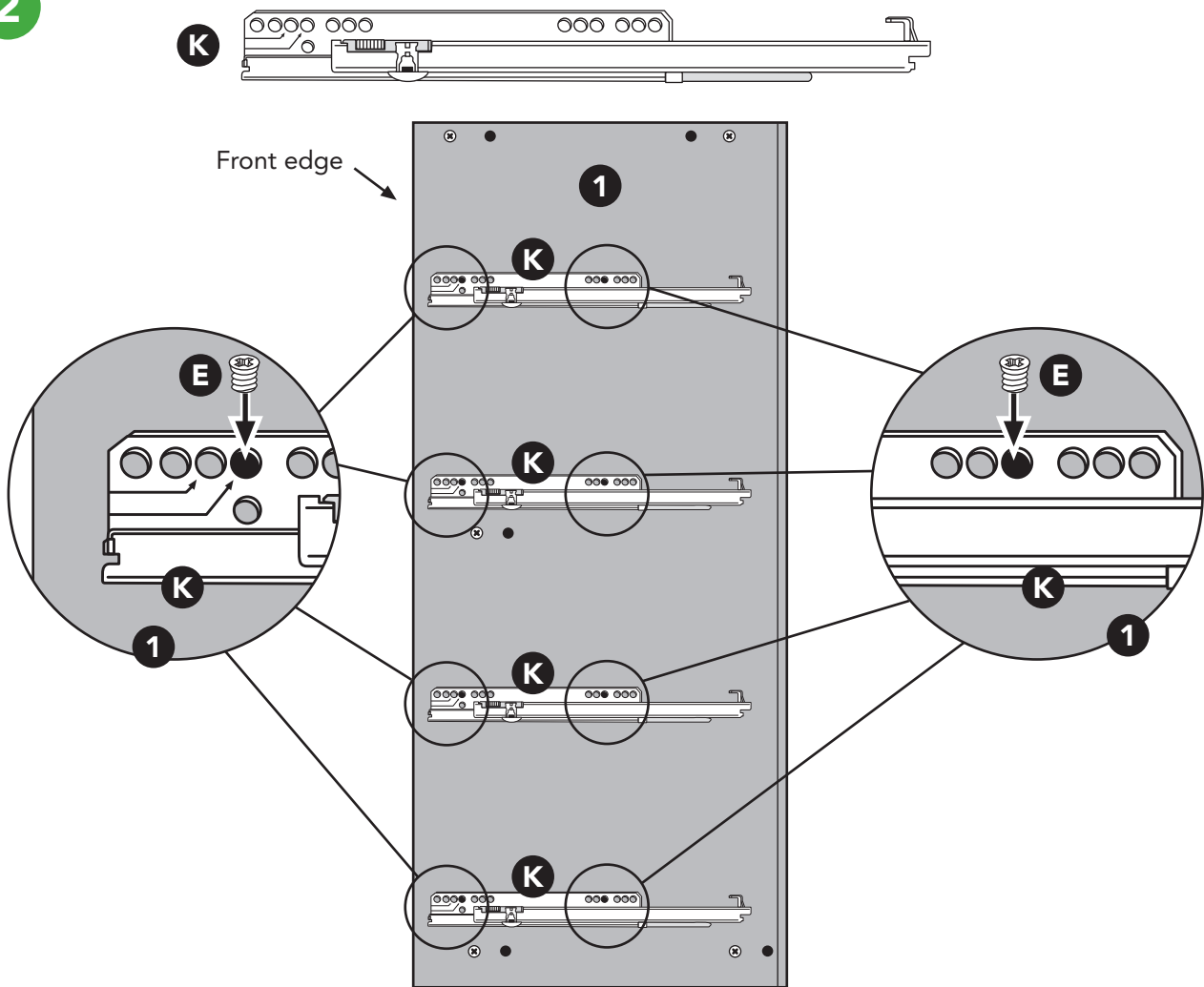
The finished surface of the drawer fronts are hi-gloss, take care when cleaning, wiping and handling these panels. There is also a protective film covering the drawer front and edges, this should be removed before the handles are attached (step 17).

Cam lock in open position

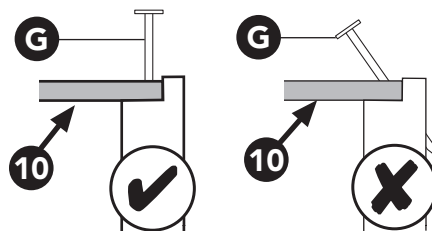
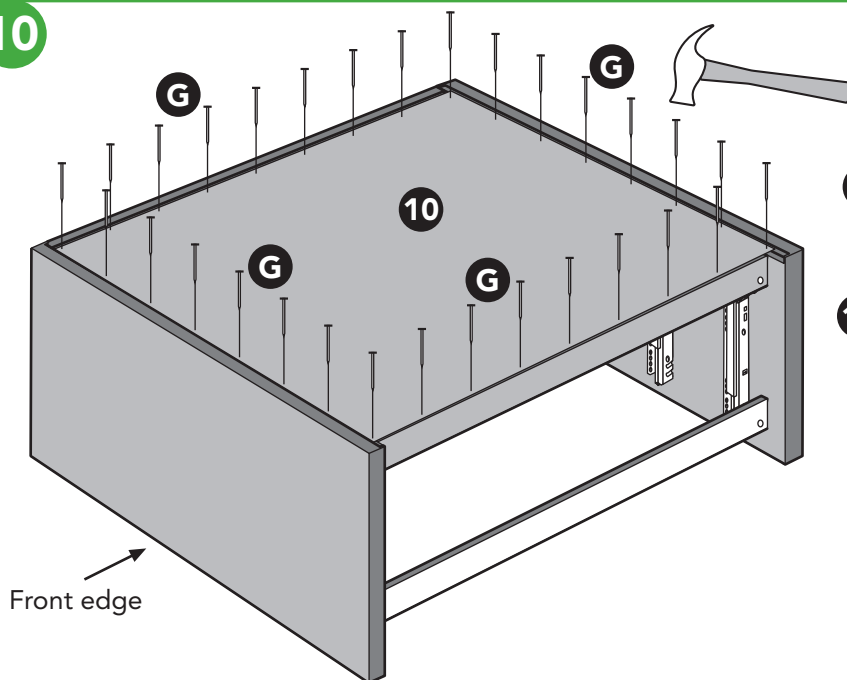
Cam lock in closed position

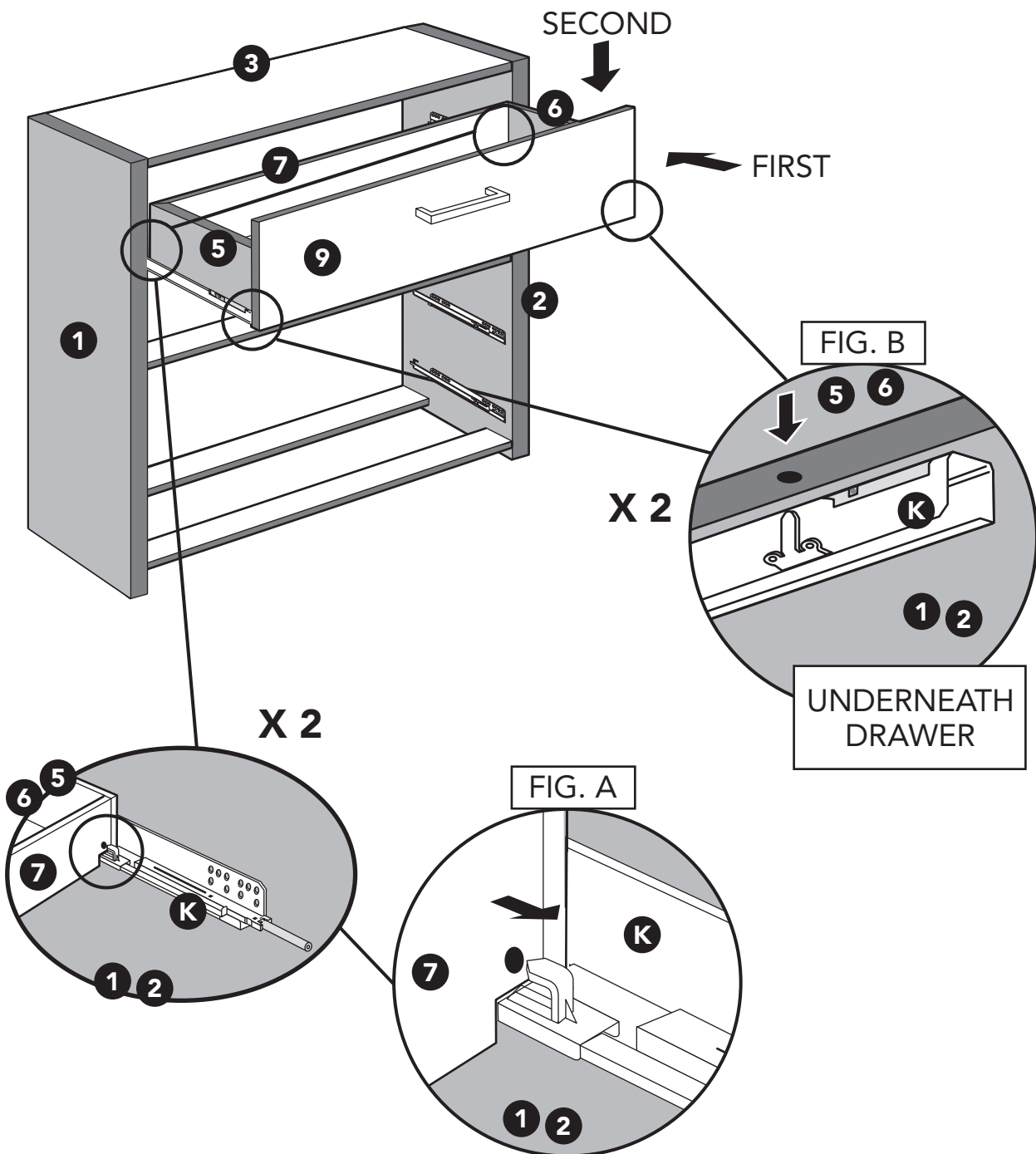

LEFT AND RIGHT DRAWER RUNNERS



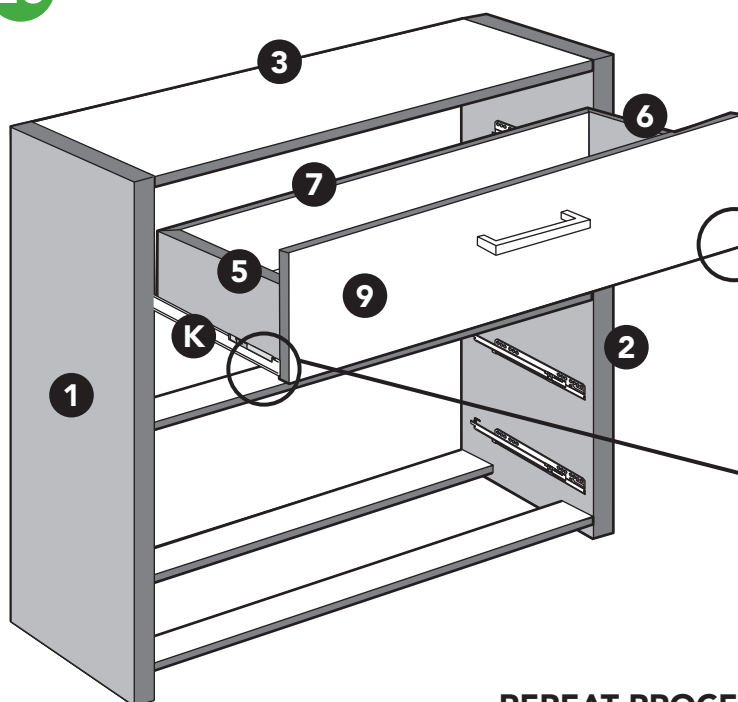

Drop drawers onto the runners and position the pegs into the holes at the back (FIG A) and on the underside of the drawer sides (FIG B).



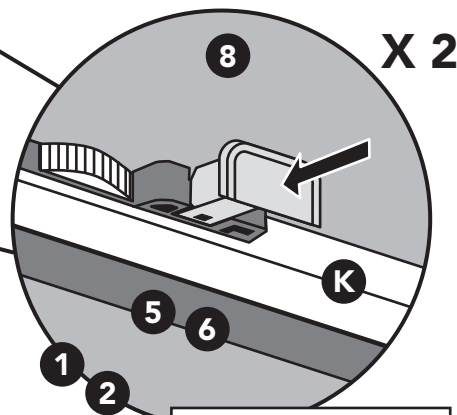
REPEAT PROCEDURE FOR THE REMAINING DRAWERS

Lift green clip up and push towards the runner (arrowed below), this secures the drawer onto the drawer runner and prevents the drawer from popping out.

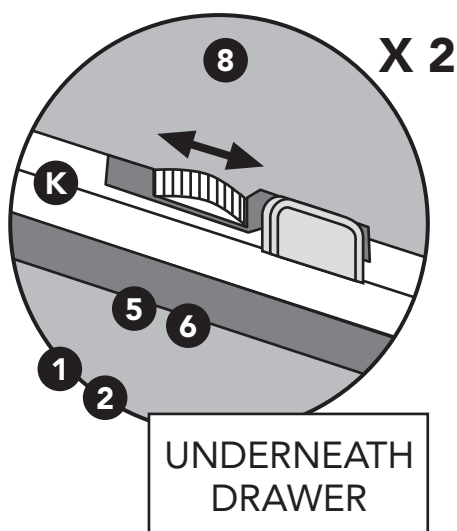

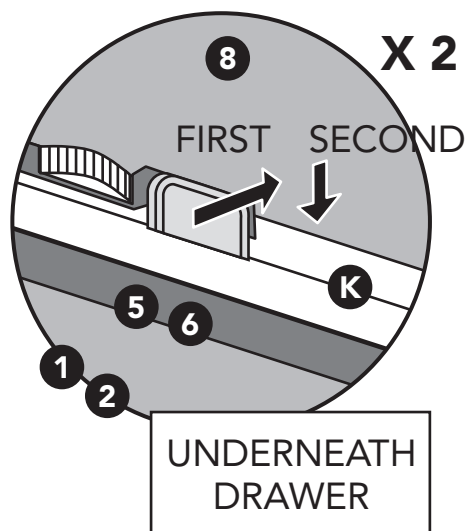

To remove the drawer pull out the green tab and clip back. Repeat the process for the other drawer runner then lift the drawer from runners.

REPEAT PROCEDURES FOR THE REMANING DRAWERS

Care and maintenance

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
